



Which intervention for Asymptomatic Carotid Stenosis?

CEA

or

CAS

Inclusion Criteria:

- Tight carotid artery stenosis, confirmed by duplex ultrasound
- No ipsilateral carotid territory symptoms for at least 6 months
- Patient is likely to live for a minimum of five years
- MRA/CTA shows that CEA and CAS are both suitable

Did you know ?

Patients are eligible for inclusion if :

- ⇒ **they have symptoms are on the contralateral side**
- ⇒ **they had symptoms on the ipsilateral side \geq 6 months before randomisation**
