Recruitment Update & Carotid Trial Collaboration

ACST-2 is the **largest** trial in the world comparing surgery and stenting in patients with tight asymptomatic carotid stenosis, having recruited 1,371 patients.

In 2014, 41 patients have been recruited. We are continuing to work closely with both **ECST-2** and **SPACE-2**, two other carotid trials which are now open for recruitment. This collaboration is very exciting and we look forward to continuing to work together in the future.

The collaborative goal at ACST-2 is to recruit over **3,000** patients, and we eventually aim to pool our data with ECST-2 & SPACE-2, allowing us to answer really important questions about carotid revascularisation.
