



# 1. Consent Form:

When taking consent, the <u>signatures must occur on the same day</u>. If a situation arises where this is not possible, please let the ACST-2 data team know immediately.

Name of patient (please PRINT),	// date (day/month/year),	the dates
Name of person countersigning consent (PRINT),	//_date (day/month/year),	must match

# 3. Presenting ACST-2 to patients:

- Describe the trial enthusiastically
  - ⇒ patients like to know how trials will help them and others
- Explore each patient's preferences
  - ⇒ Discuss carefully so that their final decision is informed
- Describe both arms of the study
  - $\Rightarrow$  avoid presenting a biased or confusing message
- Encourage patients to ask questions
